15.1 REPORT 1 – DEPUTIES SDDS – DIACONAL INSTITUTIONS

Opdrag (Acta 2003:146, 2.2)</p> <p>1.1 Die Deputate beheer alle diakonale inrigtings van die GKSA in samewerking met die plaaslike kerk in wies se ressort die bepaalde inrigting sorteer.</p> <p>1.2 Om ten opsigte van diakonale inrigtings koördinerend op te tree, met die kerkverband te skakel, geldelike hulp te bied, die administrasie en organisasie deur 'n Skakeldeputaat te reël, ingesamelde gelde vir die inrigtings te administreer.</p> <p>1.3 Om as verteenwoordigers van die kerkverband alle eiendomme wat kragtens sy opdrag verkry is, te beheer en in die regte belang daarvan op te tree.</p> <p>1.4 Om pro-aktief op te tree deur skakeling en koördinerend van alle diakonale werksaamhede van die Gereformeerde Kerke.</p> <p>1.5 Om te skakel met die owerheid en ander barmhartigheids- en liefdadigheidsinrigtings volgens KO, art 26.</p> <p>2. Sake waarvan die Sinode kennis neem</p> <p>2.1 <i>Skakeling na binne</i></p> <p>2.1.1 Die tydig beskikbaarstelling van finansiële inligting. Die Administratiewe Buro het die finansiële administrasie van SDDS oorgeneem (Acta 2003:149, 3.1) en bystand aan die Tehuise en die Bestuur van SDDS op dié terrein verleen.</p> <p>2.1.2 Die opstel van die nodige begrotings en beskikbaarstelling van maandelikse finansiële inligting.</p> <p>2.1.3 Telefoniese skakeling met die Tehuise asook besoeke een tot twee keer per jaar.</p> <p>2.1.4 'n Voordrag is by een Diaconale Kongres gelewer. Om verskeie redes, hoofsaaklik finansiël, het die hou van hierdie kongresse in onbruik verval.</p> <p>2.1.5 Briewe is aan diakonieë en Kerkrade</p>	<p>1. Mandate (Acta 2003:146, 2.2)</p> <p>1.1 The Deputies are to manage all diaconal institutions of the GKSA, in cooperation with the local church in the area of the relevant institution.</p> <p>1.2 The Deputies are to play a coordinating role with diaconal institutions, communicate with the churches, offer financial assistance, arrange administration and organisation through the Liaison deputy; and administrate collected monies for the institutions.</p> <p>1.3 Manage and act in the best interest of all property entrusted to the Deputies, as representatives of the GKSA.</p> <p>1.4 Act pro-actively in the communication and coordination of all diaconal operations of the GKSA.</p> <p>1.5 Liaise with the authorities and other charities, in accordance with CO, art 26.</p> <p>2. Matters that the Synod take note of</p> <p>2.1 <i>Internal liaising</i></p> <p>2.1.1 Financial information was provided timeously: The Administrative Bureau assumed the financial administration of the SDDS (Acta 2003:149, 3.1) and offered assistance to the Care Homes and Management of the SDDS on this terrain.</p> <p>2.1.2 The necessary budgets were drafted and the monthly financial information was made available.</p> <p>2.1.3 Telephonic liaising occurred with the Care Homes and were visited once or twice per year.</p> <p>2.1.4 A presentation was made at a Diaconal Congress. These congresses ceased for a variety of reasons, predominantly financial.</p> <p>2.1.5 Letters were sent do deaconates and</p>

In 'n toenemende mate word ongemak tydens onderhandelinge met amp-tenare ondervind.</p> <p>3. Sake waaroor die Sinode besluit <u>Aanbeveling</u> Die te benoemde Deputate die opdragte (punt 1) kontinueer.</p>	<p>Church Councils regarding a range of matters. The correspondence received varied response. Some letters didn't receive the necessary attention, while some received a great deal of support. It would seem that it's about the merit of a matter for deaconates and members.</p> <p>2.2 External liaising</p> <p>2.2.1 Liaison with the authorities The Orphanages liaised directly, where necessary, with Provincial Departments of welfare. Negotiations with officials are becoming more and more uncomfortable.</p> <p>3. Matters that the Synod decide on <u>Recommendation</u> It is recommended that the appointed Deputies continue with the instructions of the mandate (point 1).</p>
