Igreja Presbit�riana de Angola (IPB Angola)</b> Ekumeniese bande</p> <p>1.1 <i>Opdrag</i> Dat, in die lig van die nabyheid van die lande aan Suid Afrika, vorige kontakte en sendingwerk wat daar plaasvind, kontak met kerke in Angola en Mosambiek gemaak word.</p> <p><u>Vir kennisname</u></p> <p>1.2 <i>Uitvoering van opdrag</i></p> <p>1.2.1 n Persoonlike besoek is deur dr WC Opperman op 23 Oktober 2014 gedoen en predikante van die IPB Angola is in Luanda ontmoet. Gesprek is gevoer met verteenwoordigers van die Bybelskool van die IPB in Luanda. Behoeftes ten opsigte van teologiese opleiding en toerusting van lidmate (veral vroue) is uitgespreek.</p> <p>1.2.2 Daar is met ds Jacob Schoeman van die NG Kerk Namibi� kontak gemaak. Hy is leier van ’n uitreik na Presbiteriaanse kerke in Angola. Hy bedien gemeentes in die Suide van Angola en het kennis van die teologiese opleidingsplekke. Voelers is uitgesteek om teologiese opleiding en toerusting te ko�rdineer tussen GKSA, NGK-Namibi� en Brasiliaanse Presbiteriaanse kerke.</p> <p>1.2.3 ’n Besoek is in 2016 aan Angola gedoen onder leiding van ds Jacob Schoeman. Weens verskeie praktiese struikelblokke kon geen persoon van die GKSA saamgaan nie.</p> <p>1.2.4 Daar was dus geen direkte kontak tussen Deputate van die GKSA en die IPB Angola sedert Oktober 2014 nie.</p> <p>1.2.5 Daar is reeds ekumeniese bande met die IPB Angola.</p> <p><u>Vir besluitneming</u></p> <p>1.3 <i>Aanbeveling (Opdragte aan te benoemde Deputate)</i> Dat die Ekumeniese Bande in die praktyk opgevolg word en besin word</p>	<p><b>1. Igreja Presbit�riana de Angola (IPB Angola)</b> Ecumenical ties</p> <p>1.1 <i>Mandate</i> In light of the proximity of the countries to South Africa, previous contact and mission work, contact is to be made with churches in Angola and Mozambique.</p> <p><u>To be noted</u></p> <p>1.2 <i>Execution of mandate</i></p> <p>1.2.1 Dr WC Opperman made a personal visit to Angola on 23 October 2014 and met with ministers of the IPB Angola in Luanda. A meeting was held with representatives of the IPS’s Bible School in Luanda and needs related to theological training and equipping of members (especially women) were expressed.</p> <p>1.2.2 Contact was made with Rev Jacob Schoeman of the NG Kerk Namibia. He leads the outreach to Presbyterian churches in Angola, serving congregations in the south of Angola, and could provide information about the theological training institutions. Feelers were put out in regard to the coordination of theological training and equipping between the GKSA, NGK Namibia and Brazilian Presbyterian churches.</p> <p>1.2.3 Rev Jacob Schoeman led a visit to Angola in 2016, but a variety of practical obstacles prevented a delegate from the GKSA from going.</p> <p>1.2.4 There has thus been no direct contact between Deputies of the GKSA and the IPB Angola since October 2014.</p> <p>1.2.5 Ecumenical ties have already been established with the IPB Angola.</p> <p><u>To be decided</u></p> <p>1.3 <i>Recommendation (Mandate for the appointed Deputies)</i> Ecumenical ties should be practically followed-up and it should be investigated</p>
