Sake waarvan die Sinode kennis neem</p> <p>2.1 Die belangrikste sake wat aandag moes kry, is: kerklike administrasie, kerklike vergaderings, finansiële bestuur en -administrasie, ramings, fondse, argief, kerklike eiendomme, versorging van die predikant (KO, artt 11, 13 & 20) en die GKSA Predikante Pensioenfonds. Die doel is om hulp te bied.</p> <p>2.2 Die terugvoering uit die meeste kerke is baie positief omdat heelwat hulp gegee kon word en inligting deurgegee kon word.</p> <p>2.3 Die Deputate het 'n inligtingsboekie saamgestel, wat as handleiding deur kerke gebruik kan word. Beskikbaar op die webblad: gksa.org.za</p> <p>2.4 Skakelwerk: dit word voortdurend gedoen en Deputate besoek plaaslike kerke soos versoek word. Hiertydens word advies gevra en gegee oor die volgende: traktering, beroeping en beroepsbriewe, kerklike finansies, finansiële samewerking, kombinasies en -aktes, bedieningsmodelle, ens. Matters that the Synod take note of</p> <p>2.1 The most important matters, in need of attention, are: church administration, church assemblies, financial management and administration, estimates, funds, archive, church property, financial care of ministers (CO, arts 11, 13 & 20) and the GKSA Ministers Pension Fund. The goal is to offer support.</p> <p>2.2 The feedback from most of the churches were very positive, since a great deal of assistance could be offered and information conveyed.</p> <p>2.3 The Deputies has compiled an information booklet, for use by the churches. Available on the webpage: gksa.org.za</p> <p>2.4 Public relations work is ongoing and the Deputies visit local churches upon request, during which advice is sought and given on the following: salaries; calling and call letters; church finances; financial cooperation; combinations and deeds; ministry models, etc. Such advice is also given via e-mail and telephonically (as cost-saving measure).</p> <p>2.5 Meeting with Church Councils may lead to the collection of certain outstanding ramings.</p> <p>2.6 The Deputies have set a timeframe in which to visit churches to recover</p>
