Matters that the Synod take note of</b></p> <p>2.1 <u>Youth Seminar 2015</u></p> <p>2.1.1 The Deputies Youth Care presented a youth seminar on 27-28 October 2015, in cooperation with prof G Breed of the TSP, in Potchefstroom.</p> <p>2.1.2 The cost was covered by both the Faculty of Theology and the attendees. The Deputies Youth Care had no expenditure.</p> <p>2.1.3 The seminar focused on the findings of a (then) recent youth research project and associated themes. The fee each congress attendee paid, however, covered the cost.</p> <p>2.2.4 Approximately 40 people from <i>inter alia</i> Brits, Bellville East, Secunda and Potchefstroom attended.</p> <p>2.2.5 Very good feedback was received.</p> <p>2.3 <u>Youth Seminar 2017</u></p> <p>2.3.1 The Deputies were planning at the time of writing this Report to present a similar Youth Seminar DV end 2017.</p> <p>2.4 <u>RCYM Seminar 2016</u></p> <p>2.4.1 A national event, in cooperation with the RCYM, was held from 16 to 19 June 2016 at the GK Ikageng.</p> <p>2.4.2 The Deputies offered the RCYM advice.</p> <p>2.4.3 The Deputies Youth Care sponsored R100 per congress attendee to a maximum of 250 people.</p> <p><b>Decision: Points 2.1 to 2.4.3 noted.</b></p> <p><b>3. Matters that the Synod decide on</b></p> <p>3.1 The Deputies continue arranging Youth Seminars.</p> <p>3.2 The Deputies keep the costs of seminars as low as possible.</p> <p>3.3 The amount per congress attendee can be sponsored and that the Deputies make provision for this in their annual budget.</p> <p><b>Decision: Points 3.1 to 3.3 approved.</b></p> |
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
