Opdrag: Acta:2015:251, 3.2 “Dit word aanbeveel dat die Sinode CO-deputate aanwys om kennis te neem en te rapporteer van tendense in die kurrikulum en die onderwys mbt die wyse waarop die Christelike leer en etos daarin beslag kry al dan nie. Kerkrade, ouers en onderwysers moet waar nodig ook hieroor geadviseer word”.</p> <p>Besluit: Kennis geneem.</p> <p>2. Sake waarvan die Sinode kennis neem</p> <p>2.1 <i>Ex-Model C Skole (Openbare Skole) meestal gesog</i> Ex-Model C skole is in aanvraag omdat dit goeie onderwys teen ‘n redelike bekostigbare prys lewer. Die privaat-skoolonderwys groei in die meeste gevalle waar daar nie ‘n Ex-model C skool beskikbaar is nie of die plek beperk is soos in die stedelike gebiede, bv in die ooste van Pretoria. So- ver ons kennis strek het daar nog nie openbare Afrikaanse Hoërskool in Suid-Afrika tot stand gekom nie sedert 1994 nie. Die goeie skole wat ons nou het moet behou en versterk word. Veral op die platteland is die meeste Ex-Model C skole parallelmedium. Dit wil sê dit bied ‘n Afrikaanse en Engelse stroom in dieselfde skool. Die aansoeke van ouers en leerders wat in Engelsmedium in Ex-Model C skole onderrig wil word, oorskry altyd die</p>	<p>1. Mandate (Acta 2015:251, 3.2) “It is recommended that the Synod appoint Deputies CE to take note of and report on trends in curriculum and education in terms of the way in which Christian learning and ethos occupies a place therein or not. Church Councils, parents and teachers are to be advised accordingly, when necessary”.</p> <p>Decision: Noted.</p> <p>2. Matters that the Synod take note of</p> <p>2.1 <i>Former Model C Schools (public schools) sought after</i> Former Model C schools are highly desirable, because it offers a good education at a relatively affordable cost. Private school education tends to grow whenever there are no former Model C schools in the area or numbers are limited, as in urban areas like the east of Pretoria. As far as we know, no new public Afrikaans high schools have been established in South Africa since 1994. The good schools we have need to be retained and strengthened. Most of the former Model C schools in rural areas are double-medium schools, offering an education in both Afrikaans and English in the same school. The applications of parents and learners seeking to receive education in English in former Model C schools vastly exceed the places available.</p>
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<p>beskikbare ruimte by verre.</p> <p>2.2 <i>Behoud en uitbou van hoë gehalte skole</i> Bogenoemde is 'n kern belangrike taak van elke betrokke gemeenskap. Indien 'n skool tot niet gaan is dit uiteindelik maar die gemeenskaplike skuld van die betrokke gemeenskap. Soos genoem onder die eerste punt verskaf Ex-Model C skole goeie onderwys. Waarskynlik is die meeste kinders in die Gereformeerde Kerke in Suid-Afrika in Ex-Model C skole.</p> <p>2.3 <i>Beheerliggaamverkiegings Maart 2018</i> Ouers moet aangemoedig word om te staan en te stem in bogenoemde verkiesings. Die Beheerliggaam bepaal die etos, aard en karakter van 'n betrokke skool. Daarby bepaal huidige wetgewing dat beheerliggame die bevoegdheid het om te bepaal wie die onderwysers is wat vir hulle kinders skool hou. Die beheerliggaam is ook verantwoordelik vir die finansiële bestuur van 'n skool. In kerkverband behoort ouers aangemoedig te word om betrokke te wees.</p> <p>2.4 <i>Sukessiebeplanning en leierskap</i> Daar is 'n groot tekort aan potensiële onderwysleiers in hoofposte. Die vraag oorskry die aanbod. Soos die huidige geslag hoofde aftree sal hierdie tekort groter word. Die ouderdomsprofiel van hoofde is grys wat hierdie feit verder onderstreep. Daarom moet beheerliggame en ouers van betrokke skoolgemeenskappe baie sterk kyk na sukessiebeplanning en vroegtydig geskikte kandidate werf om aansoek te doen vir vakante hoofposte. Soos met die kaptein van 'n skip is dit 'n bewese feit dat hoofde wat nie die mas opkom nie, 'n baie negatiewe invloed het op die groei en ontwikkeling van 'n skool.</p> <p>2.5 <i>Dienslewering deur die Departemente van Onderwys</i> Groot probleme word ondervind met die betaling van salarisse en toelae (bv tydelike onderwysers). Departemente van Onderwys het gewoonlik nie die nodige kapasiteit om administratiewe funksies effektief te verrig nie.</p> <p>2.6 <i>Godsdien in skole saak</i> Dit is vir die Ex-Model C skole en belanghebbendes soos die SAOU en</p>	<p>2.2 <i>Retaining and expanding high-quality schools</i> The above is a crucial task for every community. It is usually the relevant community's fault when a school closes down. As mentioned, former Model C schools offer a good education and it is safe to assume that most children of the GKSA attend former Model C schools.</p> <p>2.3 <i>Governing body elections March 2018</i> Parents must be encouraged to stand for and vote in such elections. The Governing body determines the ethos, nature and character of a school. According to current legislation, governing bodies have the power to choose the teachers that are to educate their children and they are also responsible for the financial management of a school. Parents within the GKSA need to be encouraged to become involved.</p> <p>2.4 <i>Succession planning and leadership</i> There is a great shortage of potential education leaders in high-ranking posts, the demand exceeds the supply and with the retirement of the current generation of principals this shortage will only increase. The age profile of principals is a grey area, which is also a contributing factor. Governing bodies and parents of school communities therefore need to carefully review their succession planning and timeously recruit suitable candidates to apply for vacant principal posts. As with the captain of a ship, it is a proven fact that principals who are not up to the job have a negative impact on the growth and development of a school.</p> <p>2.5 <i>Service delivery by the Department of Education</i> Payment of remuneration and benefits (e.g. temporary teachers) is tremendously problematic at present. The various departments of education simply don't have the capacity to conduct their administrative functions effectively.</p> <p>2.6 <i>Religion in schools</i> It is very important to former Model C schools and stakeholders such as the</p>

It stipulates that the religious character of a school may be determined by the governing body, as long as participation occurs in a voluntary and non-discriminatory manner. It has allowed former Model C schools to have, for example, a Christian ethos and the courts have confirmed the 2003 Policy on Religion and Education. In future provincial departments of education will probably take greater care to ensure that the policy is enforced. It is important for schools (e.g.) to make provision for separate school openings should non-Christian parents request it.</p> <p>Decision: Points 2.1 to 2.6 noted.</p> <p>3. En om die ontwikkelde strategie dan aan alle belanghebbendes beskikbaar te stel.</p> <p>Besluit: Goedgekeur.</p>	<p>Decision: Approved.</p> <p>2.2 The Deputies must, as far as it is possible, stay up to date of all the newest educational developments and share the latest information as well as advice with the Church Councils and relevant interested parties.</p> <p>Decision: Approved.</p> <p>2.3 The CO Deputies can, in co-operation with the Deputies Legal Matters, as it is necessary, assist Churches in the application of the Church Order (CO, art 21).</p> <p>Decision: Approved.</p> <p>2.4 The mandate is given to the CO Deputies to assist Church Councils, educators, parents and children in matters of education in light of possible legal disputes or development of new relevant legislation.</p> <p>Decision: Approved.</p> <p>2.5 Where possible, the CO Deputies must liaise with the Deputies Ecumenicity in the development of a joint strategy.</p> <p>Decision: Approved.</p> <p>2.6 The CO Deputies, in consultation with the Deputies Legal Matters and other experts receive the assignment to, where necessary, develop a relevant strategy in reaction on the organised onslaught in the courts against a Christian world- and lifeview. And to make available the developed strategy to all interested parties.</p> <p>Decision: Approved.</p>
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
