#### C. REPORT

##### 1. Mandate

(Acta 2009:98, 5.1.1.1)

Appoint knowledgeable persons on an *ad hoc* basis, in the event of Bible Media making use of advisory panels with regard to the selection of manuscripts.

##### 2. Matters that the Synod take note of

- 2.1 Liaison with Bible Media took place on 25 February 2014.
- 2.2 Matter of notice from the liaison:
  - 2.2.1 Bible Media gives an open invitation to experts from the Reformed Church to share in the publishing of books and products of value in equipping believers.
  - 2.2.2 Bible Media is sending the magazine “*Kruisgewys*” to every reverend. If ministers do not wish to receive the magazine they can notify Bible Media by e-mailing ([info@bmedia.co.za](mailto:info@bmedia.co.za)).
  - 2.2.3 Bible Media boldly asked reverends to write articles to be taken up in the magazine “*Kruisgewys*” and submit their article to them.
  - 2.2.4 Bible Media makes the catalog available to Deputies with the possibility that they could recommend appropriate publications and products for viewing and use in the Reformed Churches.
  - 2.2.5 Reverends and churches are welcome to visit their website for information on all of their publications ([www.Bybel Media.co.za](http://www.Bybel Media.co.za)).
