C. REPORT

1. Matters that the Synod take note of

1.1 Synod assignments

- 1.1.1 The Synod gives instruction to the Deputies to keep abreast with development and, if necessary, act according to what the situation demands and report to the next Synod.
- 1.1.2 The Deputies for Retirement Provision are given the assignment to attend to the Medical Scheme matters.
- 1.1.3 Execute all matters assigned to them according to the accepted Stipulations of the Medical Scheme.
- 1.1.4 Everything decided during the Synod, is articulated and incorporated into the Stipulations.
- 1.1.5 “Ramings” that are in arrears has a negative impact on the honourable care of the emeriti.

Decision: Points 1.1.1 to 1.1.5 noted.

2. Matters that the Synod decide on

- 2.1 The Synod gives instruction to the Deputies to keep abreast with development and, if necessary, act according to what the circumstances demand and report to the next Synod.
- 2.2 The Deputies for Retirement Provision are given the assignment to also attend to the Medical Scheme matters.
- 2.3 Execute all matters assigned to them according to the accepted Stipulations of the Medical Scheme.
- 2.4 Everything decided during the Synod, is articulated and incorporated into the Stipulations.
- 2.5 Church Councils, Classes and Regional Synods are requested to pay serious attention to “ramings” that are in arrears and apply concerted efforts to reduce “ramings” in arrears.

Decision: Points 2.1 to 2.5 approved.
