Opdrag: (Acta 2012: 102-107, 15.3)</p> <p>1.1 Die Sinodale Deputate vir die Diaconale Sake (SDDS) van die Gereformeerde Kerke in Suid-Afrika (GKSA) is in beheer van alle diaconale tehuise en alle diaconale fondse wat Nasionaal beheer word. Die SDDS tree ook kontrolerend op en verleen steun en advies aan alle diakonieë in die GKSA. Alle bemerking vir fondsinsamelingsprojekte word deur die SDDS nasionaal gedoen en beheer. Die SDDS sal een nasionale diaconale fonds bestuur en prosesse in plek stel om diaconale steun uit die fondse te verleen aan tehuise, noodtoestande, aan diakonieë en ander diaconale behoeftes.</p> <p>Besluit: Kennis geneem.</p> <p>2. Mandate: (Acta 2012: 102-107, 15.3)</p> <p>1.1 The Synodal Deputies for the Diaconal Affairs (SDDS) of the Gereformeerde Kerke in Suid-Afrika (GKSA) manage all diaconal homes and all diaconal funds on National level. The SDDS fulfils a supervisory role and offers support and advice to all the diaconates of the GKSA. All marketing for fundraising projects are done and managed by the SDDS on national level. The SDDS will manage one national diaconal fund and put processes in place to offer diaconal support from the funds for care homes, emergencies, to diaconates and other diaconal needs.</p> <p>Decision: Noted.</p> <p>2. Matters that the Synod takes note of</p> <p>2.1 <i>Management: diaconal institutions</i></p> <p>2.1.1 See 2.1.3 of Report 2.</p> <p>2.2 <i>Management: diaconal institutions</i></p> <p>2.2.1 Each diaconal institution has its own management team elected during member meetings and approved by the deputies. Each management team selects its own chairman.</p> <p>2.2.2 The President Kruger Children's Home Pretoria is currently managed by Br Kobus Vorster.</p> <p>2.2.3 The President Kruger Children's Home Reddersburg is currently managed by Br Danie Noeth.</p> <p>2.2.4 These managers, together with their governing bodies, are responsible for the day-to-day running of the diaconal institutions and the care of the children entrusted to them.</p> <p>2.3 <i>Funds: diaconal institutions</i></p> <p>2.3.1 See 2.2.5 of Report 2.</p>
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<p>2.3.2 Die Deputate Diakonale Sake koördineer, fasiliteer en reguleer die verspreiding van fondse wat kerke bydra vir aanwending by die diakonale inrigtings.</p>	<p>2.3.2 The Deputies Diaconal Affairs coordinate, facilitate and regulate the division of funds churches contribute among the diaconal institutions.</p>
<p>2.4 <i>Fondsinsameling en bemarking</i></p>	<p>2.4 <i>Fundraising and marketing</i></p>
<p>2.4.1 In die verlede het die twee kinderhuise 'n samewerkingssooreenkoms gehad waar alle ingesamelde fondse (kerklik en nie-kerklik) in 'n gesamentlike rekening inbetaal is, waarna dit deur die Admin Buro op 'n 50/50 basis verdeel is. Sedert Mei 2021 bestaan hierdie samewerkingssooreenkoms nie meer nie.</p>	<p>2.4.1 In the past the two children's homes had a cooperation agreement where all funds (from the church and elsewhere) were deposited into a joint bank account, which was then divided equally by the Admin Bureau. This cooperation agreement was terminated in Mei 2021.</p>
<p>2.4.2 <u>Deputate Diakonale Sake</u></p>	<p>2.4.2 <u>Deputies Diaconal Affairs</u></p>
<p>2.4.2.1 Op advies van die Deputate Diakonale Sake se ouditeure en aan die hand van die Deputate se opdrag soos uiteengesit in die diakonale inrigtings se konstitusies dat die Deputate in beheer is van alle diakonale Kinderhuise en dal alle fondse nasionaal beheer word, is besluit dat alle fondse wat vanuit die kerkverband ontvang word voortaan in die Deputate se rekening inbetaal moet word waarna die Admin Buro die nodige verdeling na die onderskeie kinderhuise sal maak. Waar dit nie gespesifiseer word nie word hierdie fondse steeds 50/50 tussen die kinderhuise verdeel. Sou 'n gemeente dit egter vir 'n spesifieke kinderskenk word toegesien dat die fondse na die betrokke kinderskenk uitbetaal word.</p>	<p>2.4.2.1 Upon the advice of the auditors of the Deputies Diaconal Affairs and in accordance to the Deputies' instruction, as set out in the constitutions of the diaconal institutions, whereby the Deputies manage all diaconal children's homes and all funds are managed nationally, it was decided that all funds from the churches would henceforth be deposited into the Deputies' bank account. The Admin Bureau will then divide the funds among the children's homes on a 50/50 basis, unless specified otherwise. Should a congregation however make a donation to a specific children's home, the funds will be paid out to the relevant children's home.</p>

Matters that the Synod decides on</p> <p>3.1 Recommendation: The instruction to the next deputies regarding diaconal institutions should be amended as follows:</p> <p>3.1.1 <u>The Deputies Diaconal Affairs</u></p> <p>3.1.1.1 manage all the diaconal institutions of the GKSA;</p> <p>3.1.1.2 manage and administrate all diaconal funds from the GKSA to the benefit of the diaconal institutions;</p> <p>3.1.1.3 play a coordinative role with regard to diaconal institutions;</p> <p>3.1.1.4 communicate with the churches of the GKSA; and</p> <p>3.1.1.5 offer financial aid.</p> <p>Decision: Points 3.1 to 3.1.1.5 approved.</p>
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
