Met groot dank aan Johan Coetzee en sy span van die Admin Buro wat groot moeite hiermee gedoen het.</p>	<p><b>Decision: Points 4.1.1 to 4.1.4 noted.</b>  <u>Matters that the Synod takes note of</u>  4.2 <i>Fulfilment of task</i>  4.2.1 The Synod is to take note that the TEA, ICRC or WRF have not held conferences, where contact could be made with this church, since the previous Synod due to the Covid-19 pandemic.  4.2.2 Dr Flip Buys visited these churches in 2017.  4.2.3 Regular correspondence continued between the GKSA and SRC.  4.2.4 The needs of these churches were regularly brought to the attention of the churches of the GKSA. The Deputies requested an emergency loan plan from the SRC that the funds donated may be paid over. They submitted such a plan and a large amount was paid over in 2021. Sincere thanks to Johan Coetzee and his team at the Admin Bureau for all the effort they put in.</p>
