Igreja Presbit�eriana de Angola (IPB Angola) Ecumenical ties</p> <p>1.1 <i>Mandate</i> Ecumenical ties should be practically followed-up and it should be investigated on which terrains cooperation in terms of theological training, equipping and cooperation with other stakeholders can be achieved. Possible cooperation with the NG Kerk should be considered.</p> <p>Decision: Noted. <u>Matters that the Synod takes note of</u></p> <p>1.2 <i>Execution of mandate</i></p> <p>1.2.1 The GKSA already has ecumenical ties with the Igreja Presbiteriana de Angola (IPA).</p> <p>1.2.2 Dr HM Zwemstra (deputy), Dr Callie Opperman (previous deputy), Rev. Stephanu de Villiers (from the GK Grootfontein) and Rev. Jacob Schoeman (from the NG Kerk) visited delegates from the IPA in Ondjiva (South Angola) from 16-19 July 2018.</p> <p>1.2.3 The Reformed Churches Grootfontein, Tsumeb and Pretoria-Annlin went on an outreach to Ondjiva in Angola from 8-14 July 2019. The purpose of the outreach was to train church leaders and to strengthen the relationship with the IPA.</p> <p>1.2.4 Due to the Covid-19 pandemic further visits and outreaches were not possible.</p> <p>1.2.5 Dr HM Zwemstra had an online meeting with representatives of the IPA</p>

This training can be through distance programmes, outreaches, and material. The language used in Angola, namely Portuguese, makes training from South Africa and Namibia difficult.
