Opdrag</b> 1.1 Acta 2018:154, 3.1-3.2: 1.1.1 Die Deputate gaan voort om kampe en projekte van plaaslike kerke met advies en bemarking te ondersteun. 1.1.2 Die ondersoek na 'n nasionale jeugkamp en/of -toer word steeds op die agenda van die te benoeme Deputate Jeugsorg gehou. <b>Besluit: Punte 1.1 tot 1.1.2 kennis geneem.</b></p> <p><b>2. Sake waarvan die Sinode kennis neem</b> 2.1 Die Deputate Jeugsorg het nie die Frankfort-riviertoer of die Boland Seekamp georganiseer nie. Die logistieke reëlings word deur plaaslike gemeentes behartig. Die Deputate Jeugsorg het hierdie inisiatiewe, soos ander jeugkampe en projekte regoor die land, met bemarking, finansies en toerustingsmateriaal ondersteun. 2.2 <i>Bybelpasingstoer na Malawi</i> 2.2.1 Voor die toer was daar hard gewerk om genoeg fondse in te samel vir Bybels. Daar was genoeg fondse verkry sodat daar saam Harvesters Ministries 3150 Bybels (Chichewa en Engels) kon aankoop en by 380 kerke in Malawi in die Monkey Bay-omgewing kon plaas. Saam met die Bybels was daar ook 1700 tweetalige Engels-Chechewa Heidelbergse Kategismus-boekies aan die leiers uitgedeel. 2.2.2 Die Bybels word egter ook nie net op die straat uitgedeel nie; Harvesters Ministries bepaal die spesifieke behoeftes. 2.2.3 Ons toergroep het uit 49 gelowiges (waarvan 30 GKSA jongmense was)</p>	<p><b>1. Mandate</b> 1.1 Acta 2018:154, 3.1-3.2: 1.1.1 The Deputies are to continue supporting the camps and projects of local churches with advice and marketing. 1.1.2 The possibility of a national youth camp and/or tour is to remain on the agenda of the next Deputies Youth Ministry. <b>Decision: Points 1.1 to 1.1.2 noted.</b></p> <p><b>2. Matters that the Synod takes note of</b> 2.1 The Deputies Youth Ministry did not organise the Frankfort River Tour or the Boland Sea Camp. The logistics are handled by local churches. The Deputies Youth Ministry supported these initiatives, as with other youth camps and projects across the country, by means of marketing, finances and equipping material. 2.2 <i>Bible Distribution Tour to Malawi</i> 2.2.1 Prior to the tour, great effort was made to raise sufficient funds for Bibles. Enough funds were raised to purchase, together with Harvesters Ministries, 3 150 Bibles (Chichewa and English) for distribution in 380 churches in the Monkey Bay area of Malawi. The leaders also received 1 700 bilingual English-Chechewa Heidelberg Catechism booklets. 2.2.2 The Bibles were not merely distributed the street; Harvesters Ministries first determined specific needs. 2.2.3 The tour group consisted of 49 believers (of which 30 were GKSA</p>

(Daar het net 13 mense ingeskryf vir die toer.)</p> <p>2.4 Gemeentes wat hulp gevra het met kampe en projekte is vanuit die Jeugkantoor ondersteun.</p> <p>2.5 Die Deputate Jeugsorg bied ook hul hulp aan in die vorm van toerustingmateriaal. Kyk Rapport 4.</p> <p><b>Besluit: Punte 2.1 tot 2.5 kennis geneem.</b></p> <p><b>3. Sake waaroor die Sinode besluit</b></p> <p>3.1 Die Deputate kry opdrag om, in samewerking met Streeksinode en Klassisse plaaslike kerke in jeugsorg te ondersteun in die reël van kampe, uitreike en projekte.</p> <p><b>Besluit: Goedgekeur (wysiging reeds aangebring – Deputate Handeling).</b></p> <p>3.2 Die Deputate Jeugsorg moet ondersoek onder die gemeentes doen om uit te vind wat die jeug wil bywoon.</p> <p><b>Besluit: Goedgekeur.</b></p>	<p>youth) from across the country. Eleven drivers made their vehicles available for the tour.</p> <p>2.2.4 Rev Johannes Aucamp of Topia provided the groups with equipping material about discipleship as well as about the African and Western worldview.</p> <p>2.2.5 Since approximately half the tour was spent driving, Bible studies were compiled for the different group to do in their vehicles.</p> <p>2.3 <i>2020 Train Tour (April)</i></p> <p>2.3.1 The Deputies Youth Ministry spent long hours planning a train tour to the Cape, which did not realise due to a lack of interest (only 13 entries were received for the tour.)</p> <p>2.4 Churches who requested help with camps and projects were supported by the Youth Office.</p> <p>2.5 The Deputies Youth Ministry also offer aid in the form of equipping material. See Report 4.</p> <p><b>Decision: Points 2.1 to 2.5 noted.</b></p> <p><b>3. Matters that the Synod decide on</b></p> <p>3.1 The to be named Deputies are instructed to support local churches, in collaboration with Regional Synods and Classes, in youth care in arranging camps, outreaches and projects.</p> <p><b>Decision: Approved (amendment already made – Deputies Acta).</b></p> <p>3.2 The Deputies Youth Ministry should do research among the churches to determine the kind of activities the youth prefer.</p> <p><b>Decision: Approved.</b></p>
