21.4 QUESTION OF ADVICE FROM REGIONAL SYNOD RANDVAAL – WOMEN IN SPECIAL OFFICES AS ELDER AND MINISTER (Art 38)

Motivering

Die onsekerheid en inkonsekwente optrede in verband met bogenoemde vrae het vir geruime tyd al die kerke in beroering gebring.

Dit kan tot heil en seën vir die kerk wees, en kan die eenheid van die kerk dien, as die Sinode hom duidelik en ondubbelsinnig in hierdie verband uitspreek.

Question 3

Are there then any grounds in Scripture or Confession to in any way deny church-denominations, congregations or individual members, that support the point of view and exegesis in Colum A, ecumenical ties with or membership of the GKSA?

Motivation

The uncertainty and inconsequent conduct with regard to these questions has for a considerable time stirred up strife in the churches.

It will be to the welfare and blessing of the church, and can serve the unity of the church, if the Synod can give clear and unequivocal answers in this regard.
