Sake waarvan die Sinode kennis neem</p> <p>1.1 <i>Opdrag</i>: Handeling 2018:933</p> <p>1.1.1 Om in samewerking met Radio Pretoria, SAUK (Triple M Produksies), Radiokansel en ander gelisensieerde uitsaaiers die uitsending van eredienste, kerknuus en deelname aan Godsdienstprogramme vanuit die GKSA oor Radio en TV te reël.</p> <p>1.2 <i>Uitvoering van opdrag</i></p> <p>1.2.1 Weens verskeie faktore het die Deputate geen nuwe sake die afgelope drie jaar hanteer nie. Die uitsaai van eredienste, kerknuus en deelname aan Godsdienstprogramme het gereeld op Radio Pretoria en op verskeie geleenthede op RSG (SAUK) plaasgevind.</p> <p>Besluit: Punte 1.1 tot 1.2.1 kennis geneem.</p> <p>2. Sake waaroor die Sinode besluit</p> <p><u>Aanbevelings</u></p> <p>2.1 Dat weer Deputate aangewys word met die opdrag</p> <p>2.1.1 Om in samewerking met soveel as moontlike gelisensieerde uitsaaiers die uitsending van eredienste, kerknuus en deelname aan Godsdienstprogramme vanuit die GKSA oor Radio en TV te reël.</p> <p>2.1.2 Streeksinodes versoek word om Deputaatgroep vir Radio-uitsendings te benoem, verteenwoordigend van die onderskeie Klassis in die betrokke Streeksinode. <u>Motivering</u>: In byna elke Klassis en Streeksinode bestaan daar onafhanklike uitsaaiers waarvan die Deputate nie van bewus is nie en met wie hulle nie kontak het nie.</p> <p>Besluit: Punte 2.1 tot 2.1.2 goedgekeur.</p>	<p>1. Matters that the Synod takes note of</p> <p>1.1 <i>Instruction</i>: Acts 2018:933.</p> <p>1.1.1 The Deputies are to organise the broadcasting of church services, church news and participation in religious programmes of the GKSA, in collaboration with Radio Pretoria, SABC (Triple M Productions), Radio Pulpit and other licensed broadcasters.</p> <p>1.2 <i>Fulfilment of task</i></p> <p>1.2.1 Due to a range of factors the Deputies did not handle any new matters the past three years. Church services, church news and participation in religious programmes were regularly broadcast on Radio Pretoria and on a number of occasions on RSG (SABC).</p> <p>Decision: Points 1.1 to 1.2.1 noted.</p> <p>2. Matters that the Synod decides on</p> <p><u>Recommendations</u></p> <p>2.1 Deputies should once again be appointed and instructed to:</p> <p>2.1.1 organise the broadcasting of church services, church news and participation in religious programmes of the GKSA, in collaboration with as many licenced broadcasters as possible, on radio and TV; and</p> <p>2.1.2 request Regional Synods to appoint a Deputy group, representative of the different Classes, for radio broadcasts. <u>Motivation</u>: There are independent broadcasters in virtually every Classis and Regional Synod of which the Deputies are unaware and with which they don't have contact.</p> <p>Decision: Points 2.1 to 2.1.2 approved.</p>
