Regarding constitution</b> The Calling Church Council was forced to make a decision on the orderly handling of the Letter of credence from the Regional Synod Pretoria because there are Appeals against a decision of the Regional Synod which affects the essence of their delegation.</p>

In sy soeke om objektief tot die beste orde op te tree het die Kerkraad kerkregtelike advies ingewin en ook twee naburige Kerkrade gevra om saam met die Kerkraad te besin oor die beste wyse om die saak te hanteer.

Op 'n gesamentlike vergadering met Deputate van naburige Kerkrade is eenparig besluit om die orde so te reël:

Die Kerkraad meen dat net die Sinode self oor die aanvaarding van die Kredensiebrief kan besluit en dat die Sinode gevolglik eers gekonstitueer moes word voordat die saak – hangende die Appèlle teen die besluit – deur die Sinode self hanteer kon word.

## **2. Brief van GK Waterkloofrand**

'n "Ordevoorstel", gedateer 15 Januarie 2023, is aan die Deputate Programmering en die Roepende Kerkraad gerig met 'n voorstel dat *"kerke wat nie die Sinodebesluite aangaande die vrou in amp ooreenkomstig die reëlings in die Kerkorde as vas en bindend beskou nie, se kredensie nie deur 'n meerdere vergadering aanvaar kan word nie."* Hulle versoek die vergadering dat daar aan afgevaardigdes van hierdie kerke geen sittingsreg tydens die vergadering gegee word nie.

Die Kerkraad oordeel dat 'n Ordevoorstel net tydens 'n bestaande vergadering, waar lede wat dit indien teenwoordig is, ingedien kan word. Dit is onseker na watter vergadering die brief verwys aangesien dit aan die Deputate Programmering en die Roepende Kerkraad gerig is. Verder word 'n inhoudelike saak, wat op die Agenda van die Sinode is voortydig in 'n Ordevoorstel betrek. Buitendien raak 'n

In its quest to act objectively for the best order, the Church Council sought ecclesiastical advice and also asked two neighbouring Church Councils to reflect together with the Church Council on the best way to handle the matter.

At a joint meeting with Deputies from neighbouring Church Councils, it was unanimously decided to arrange the order in this way:

*Subject to the decision that the Synod may, after having been constituted and following the adjudication of the Appeals against the decisions of Pretoria Regional Synod, take concerning delegation, the Calling Church Council withholds for the purposes of an orderly constituting process acceptance of the received credential letter from Pretoria Regional Synod.*

The Church Council considered that only the Synod itself could decide on the acceptance of the Letter of credence and that the meeting had to be constituted as a result before the matter – pending the Appeals against the decision – could be handled by the Synod itself.

## **2. Letter from GK Waterkloofrand**

An "Order Proposal", dated January 15, 2023, was addressed to the Deputies Programming and the Calling Church Council with a proposal that *"the Credentials of churches that do not consider the Synod decisions regarding the woman in office as fixed and binding in accordance with the arrangements in the Church Order, cannot be accepted by a major meeting"*. They request the meeting that delegates from these churches are not given the right to sit during the meeting.

The Church Council considers that a Order Proposal can only be submitted during an existing meeting, by members who are present. It is uncertain which meeting the letter refers to as it is addressed to the Deputy Programming and the Calling Church Council. Furthermore, a matter of substance, which is on the Agenda of the Synod, is prematurely involved in this motion of order. Besides, a Order Proposal affects
